FNMT course structure as it currently stands:

- Discipleship 1 'Getting to know God'
- Discipleship 2 'Gifts that can be used to edify the church'
- 3. Public Speaking
- Practical Ministry—Baptism, Communion, ministry family balance, message prep, Do's and don't's etc.
- 5. Leadership Training (Kimberly based project)
- 6. Youth Ministry/Children's Ministry
- 7. Church History (AEF)
- 8. Safe Churches Training
- 9. Certificate IV in Ministry & Theology (VBC)
- 10. Diploma Ministry & Theology (VBC)

The courses mentioned above will be transformed into learning and training modules of study over the remainder of 2022, with aim to have them operational and ready mid 2023.


AEF/FNMT will be reaching out to Port Augusta and Coober Pedy South Australia in the not so distant future.











It's all about to happen?

- Discipleship 1 (AEF/FNMT Disc 001) and Discipleship 2 (AEF/FNMT Disc 002) is about to be rolled out to several locations
- Broome Anglican church has a ministry to the Aboriginal people at their night service, they have expressed interest in enlisting students in the Discipleship course as a starter for them. The Pastor has also advised He would be willing to run the leadership course for Pastors and leaders throughout identified locations in the Kimberlies, jointly with AEF/FNMT. Kununurra People's Church and Wyndham People's church are also potential sites for training. AEF/FNMT will be reaching out to them within the coming months.
- Regional towns Broome & Kununurra plus remote Communities, Nookanbah, Yerrli, One Arm Point and Wangkajunkah, are very exciting developments. With these locations we will be taking the look see approach and use it as a pilot project for better suited models to their training needs.
- 14 students from Balga Evangelical Aboriginal Church have expressed a commitment to begin the Discipleship course. We have planned to deliver this in 2 weeks. An introduction will happen on the 21st Sept.









Perth Bible College technical support person has generously assisted and supported AEF/FNMT in setting up the Moodle online teaching platform for future students of the program. Discipleship 1 has been entered on the Moodle system. However there still needs some fine tuning to be ready for launch. We are about to add Discipleship 2.
